Baltimore Road Runners Club Charlie Reynolds Scholarship Information

The Baltimore Road Runners Club is a volunteer organization committed to promoting running, fitness and healthy lifestyles among people of all ages. Charlie Reynolds was a club member who embodied this commitment. He served as club president, was a competitive runner and was a track and field and cross country coach at Calvert Hall College High School.

As a means of honoring Charlie, the Baltimore Road Runners Club (BRRC) offers a one-time scholarship of \$1,000 towards college expenses for one male and one female graduating high school senior each year.

To qualify for this year's scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a graduating senior in 2009
- Reside in Baltimore city or Baltimore county *or* attend school (public or private) in Baltimore city or Baltimore county
- Participate on their school's track and field or cross country team

In addition, *any* graduating senior who is the son or daughter of a current BRRC member is eligible to apply.

Applicants must submit the following information to the address below by June 2, 2009:

- A completed application cover page (see attachment)
- A high school transcript (grades 9 – 12)
- A list of academic and athletic honors and any other extracurricular activities
- A letter of recommendation
- A one-page essay on one of the following themes:
 - What motivates you to run
 - Who inspired you to start running (or who inspires you to continue running)
 - How you plan to incorporate running into your college experience

If you wish to combine the thematic ideas, you may.
